The new Thai Tourism and Sports Minister Phiphat Ratchakitprakarn's proposal to provide 15 day visa-free travel to Chinese and Indian tourists, was steam-rolled by the cabinet.

The cabinet resolved instead to extend the fee waiver on visas for visitors from India and other countries in the program. The program will now be extended from October 31 this year to April 30 next year, which covers the 2019 Songkran festival.

Tourism and Sports Minister Phiphat had been proposing totally visa-free travel for Chinese and Indian tourists for up to 15 days as a means to encourage tourists.
